



Experienced stonemasons find that using larger pieces expedites the installation process and offers more creative shaping and sizing options. Conversely, working with heavy full dimension stone is an arduous process demanding precision hand sculpting and working each piece to an accurate thickness.

Increasing numbers of masons, builders and homeowners are discovering the substantial labor and time saving benefits of using veneer stone rather than much denser full dimension stone. Cladding with Thinstones also reduces the need to use structural footings, and Thinstones offers the advantage of approving the final wall layout prior to installation.

Constant efficiency improvements in our production process have enabled us to become cost competitive with manufactured or cultured stone products, until recently thought of as the only affordable choice.





In addition to natural New England Thinstones we also offer options in thin bricks, pavers or Belgian blocks and provide services for veneer stone projects with customized specifications. Flagging, treads, and larger slabs are available to match most of our Thinstones line.




Corners

"It's all about the corners"...A common refrain from experienced stonemasons underscores the importance of a well proportioned corner precision cut to ninety degrees.

The corner piece is the first to be installed and ultimately sets the bar for the standard of the finished work. Corners cut by hand on a table saw are limited in size, often not squared and will likely break if sawn with an over-cut.

We use a automated corner saw with two blades set at right angles to one another capable of producing twenty inch long pieces with a consistent thickness. The larger the piece, the more options a mason will have to resize and reshape it.





Packaging

New England Thinstones offers the convenience of packaging in covered weatherproof recycling totes. Available in either 8 sq. ft. (flats) or 8 linear ft. (corners) The perfect solution if running short of material, planning a smaller weekend project or encountering on-site challenges such as elevators or a limited interior work area.

Pallets come with sturdy end gates to ensure safe and level stacking.

Flats: 200 sq. ft./pallet • 100 sq. ft./pallet • 50 sq. ft./pallet

8 sq. ft./tote

Corners: 50 linear ft./pallet • 8 linear ft./tote

New England Thinstones are 100% natural stone.

Shade and color variations are to be expected.








